



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
We Are Accountable

We are accountable for our environmental footprint. We identified greenhouse gas emissions, water usage, and waste management as material considerations integral to our sustainability and business strategy.









Appvion completed a carbon profile for three of our thermal grades, encompassing Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions.




Hazardous Waste Management
